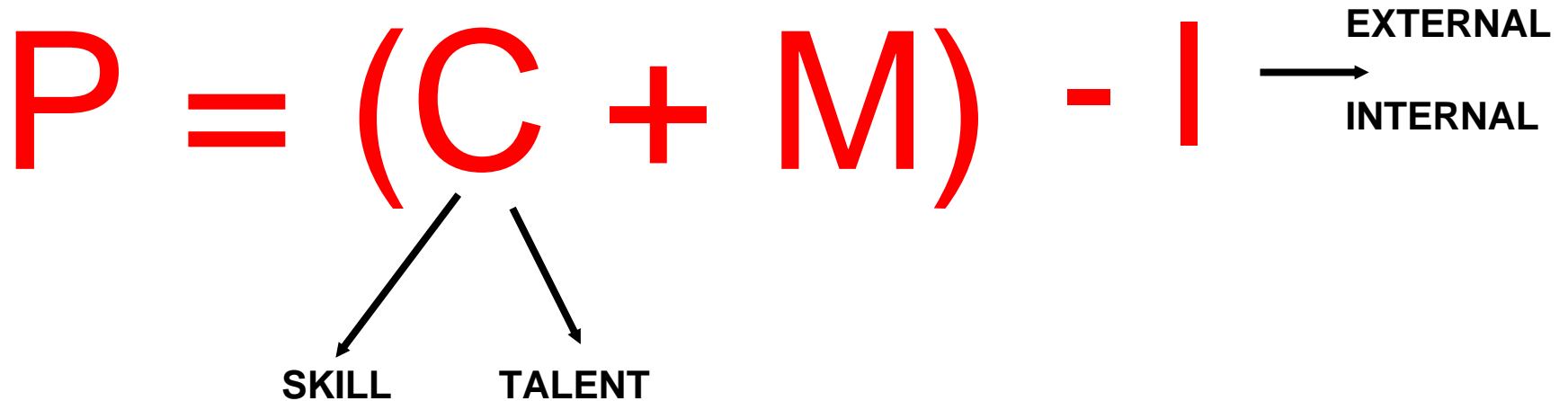

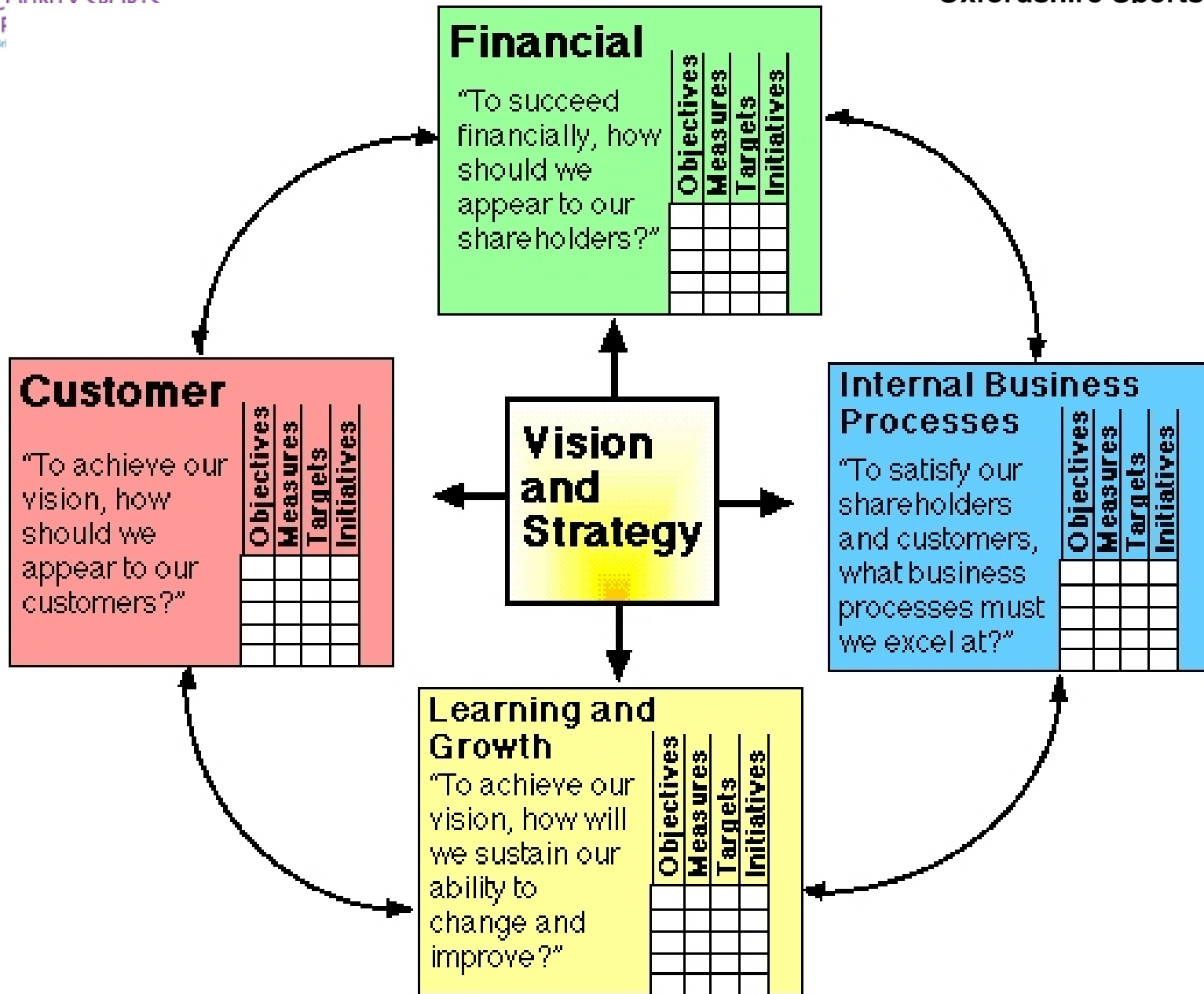

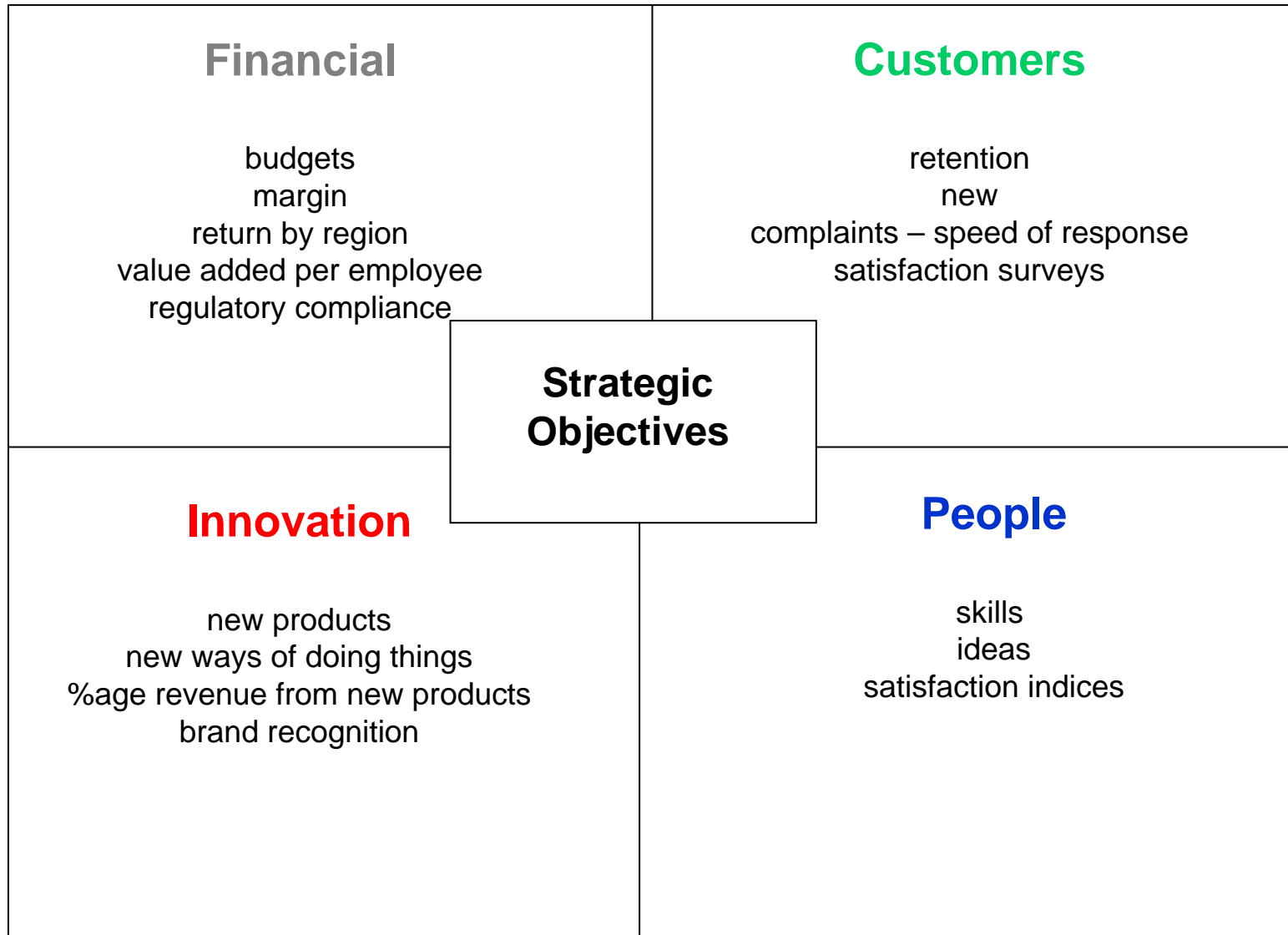

‘To be the strategic partnership for sport in Oxfordshire that delivers local, regional and national priorities in such a way that brings added value to all partners’

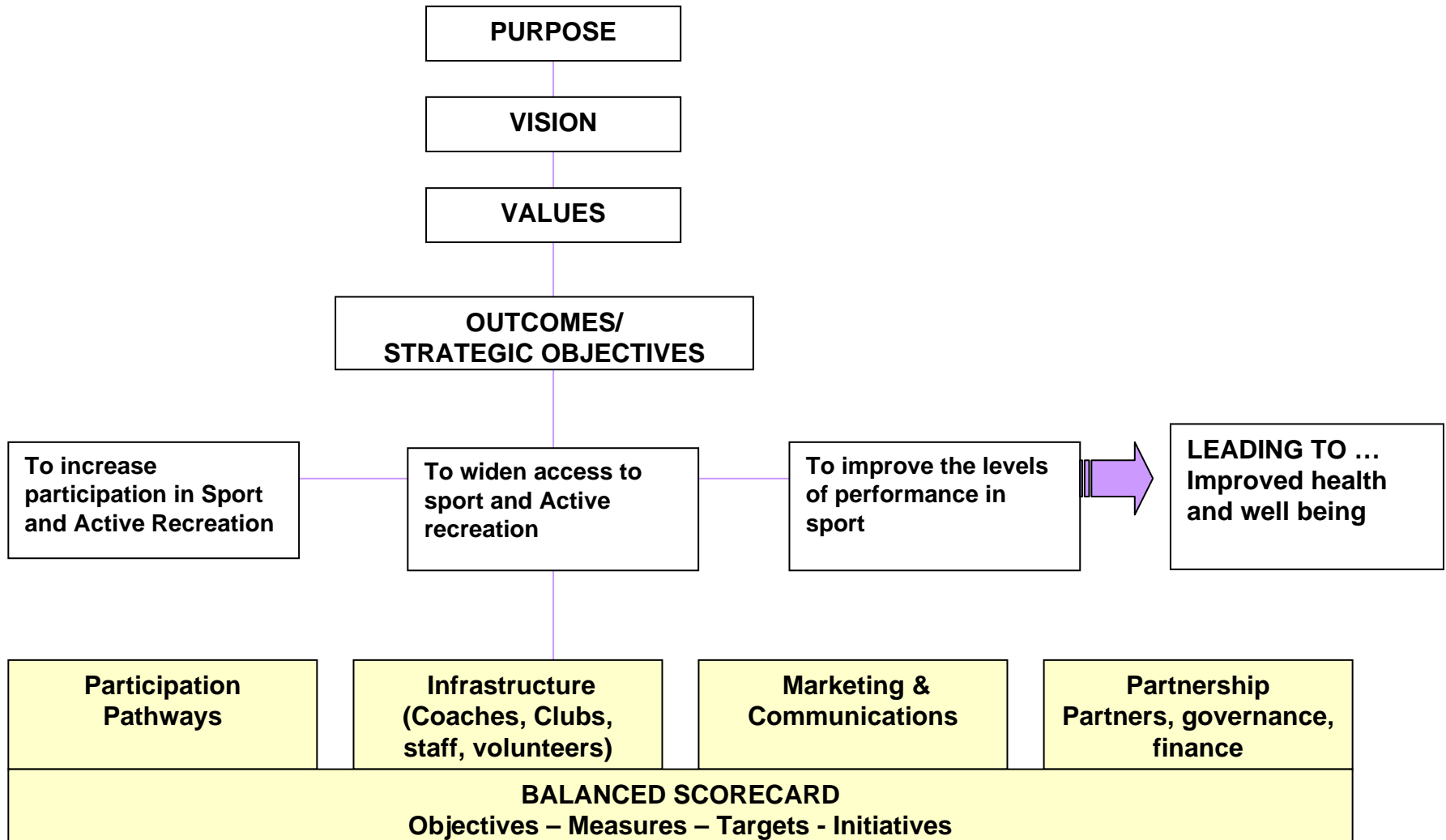
Outcomes

- Improve health and well being

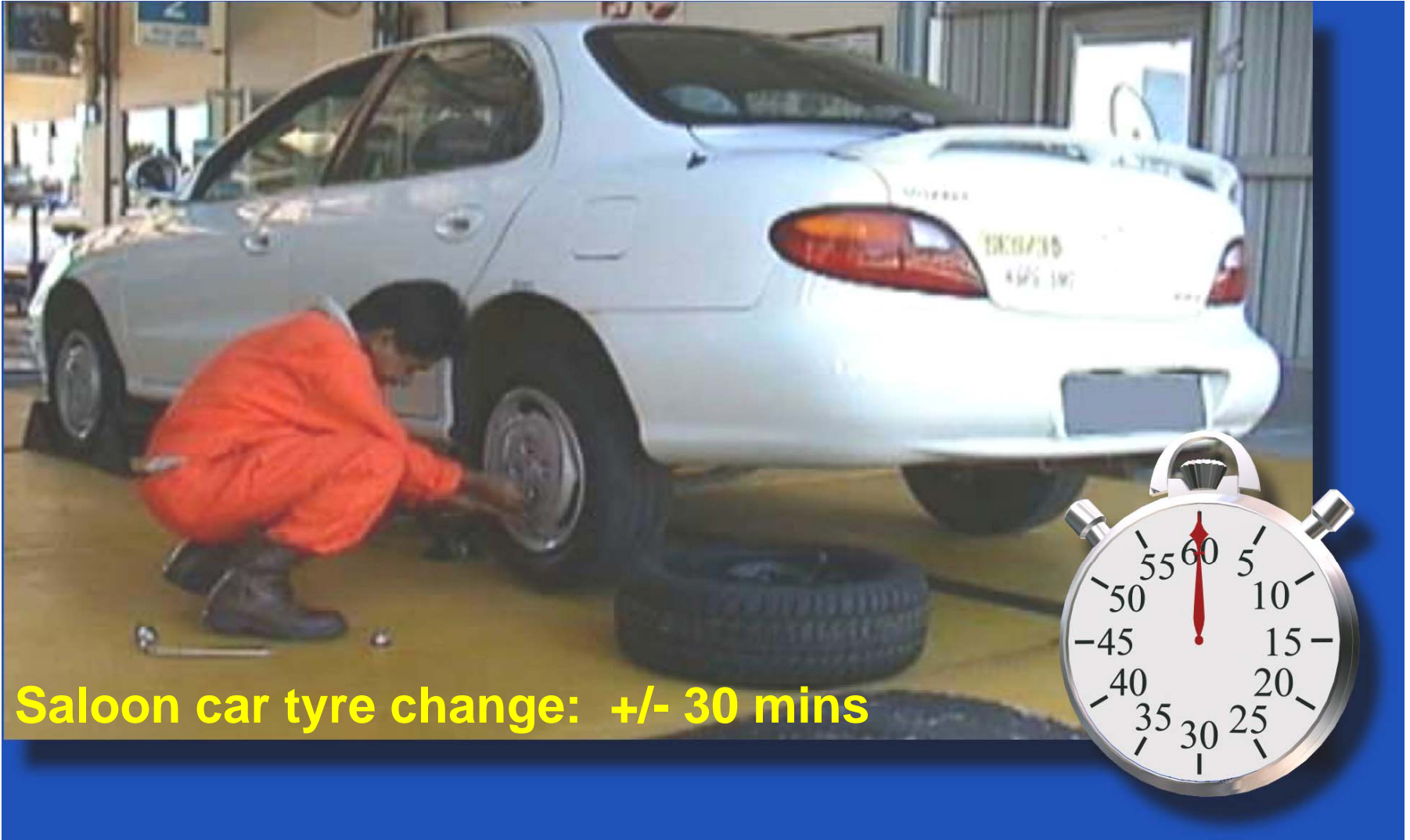
